



## Code of Conduct

Height Gate is situated within a community of residents and should never be used for the purpose of holding a party that would involve significant numbers of people arriving at random times, loud music or excess cleaning. Please respect our neighbours and the surrounding environment.

1. **Maximum group size in bunk beds is 32** internally, and with some additional space for camping available. This is for both fire safety and facilities provided.
2. Music from inside or outside should not be disturbing to Height Gate's neighbours. Between the hours of **22:00 and 08:00 the activities of Height Gate should not be audible** to our neighbours (this includes loud campfire chatter).
3. Please share directions with all guests coming to the camping barn. Double check its location as the postcode may not direct you to the correct place. A **maximum of 3 cars** per booking are allowed to be parked immediately outside the barn and entirely off the track. If required for accessibility, space for a further 5 vehicles can be made available 150m away. Please request access in advance and you must not block any access needed for neighbours or the farmer. We encourage you to **use public transport where possible**, then walk up to Height Gate. If driving we strongly encourage car sharing and keeping the number of vehicles going up the track to a minimum. Vehicles can be left in the large layby on the A646, 125m towards Hebden Bridge from the turning off to Height Gate.
4. The adult making the booking is **responsible for any damage caused** and for ensuring that the group size is known in advance and not exceeded. Any damages must be reported when departing to the Centre Co-ordinator.
5. One adult of the party must be appointed as responsible for safety/behavioural issues whilst your group is at Height Gate, they should make the group **familiar with the safety advice** provided with each booking.
6. We would expect all organised groups to have their own **policies and procedures around safeguarding** and to use these during their stay, and where relevant inform Height Gate's staff. The local safeguarding plan will be shared with you before arrival.
7. Height Gate should be **left in a clean condition** on departure. There is no rubbish collection from Height Gate, you will be responsible for **removing all of your group's recycling and rubbish** at the end of your stay.
8. There is **no smoking** anywhere inside the property, and **no fireworks** on site.
